

- Update position paper
- Commission work programme 2026 expected soon – IDAA listed as priority
- Green steel label (Q4)
 - First phase: quick
 - Second phase: more detailed based on ESPR and EPD data
- Green cement label (tbc)
 - Lead: DG GROW I.1 - raw materials, energy intensive industries (Joan Canton)

- Collaborate with others on steel label (e.g. Eurofer)
- Workshop with DG GROW to feed into position paper (cement?)




Purpose

Scoping



New versions of / replacements for existing materials

Materials that can be decarbonised using electricity, fuel or feedstock produced using CCUS

Materials where embedded CO₂ is offset eg through GGR credits

Scoping

- Geography: UK and EU
- In scope:
 - Current and projected size of the market for construction materials
 - Willingness to pay – housebuilders, mortgage providers?
 - Sectoral decarbonisation plans – timelines, barriers, needs
- Out of scope:
 - Detail on embodied emissions reporting
 - Detailed design of LCP measures
- Partners:
 - Trade associations
 - CCSA members
