

Committees, Working Groups & Forums Structure




New CCSA Working Group Structure

How will it work

- **WG meetings** to be held as and when required with a minimum of 3 meetings per year and an active workplan. Recordings and notes will be shared via HubSpot. Inactive Working Groups will be disbanded, and new groups – as well as time-limited project-specific groups - can be established to reflect changing work priorities.
- **Terms of Reference:** each WG will agree ToR to set out a workplan/key strategic priorities and deliverables for each group annually, as well as terms of engagement for WG members who will be expected to actively participate in the group.
- **Co-chairs:** each WG will have 3 co-chairs.
 - Tasks: chair meetings, agree on agenda, steer conversation, etc.

Strategy & next actions

Next actions:

- **Select co-chairs:** in case of interest, inform me by June 6 – first come, first served.
- **Review Terms of Reference (ToR):** add your feedback by June 6.

Ideas for future workstreams:

- **European grid package:** The package will propose measures to accelerate the upgrade, digitalisation and expansion of the European grid infrastructure removing bottlenecks and increasing overall efficiency for a well interconnected and resilient energy system. Deadline 5 August. Relevance for Co2 Transport:
 - Supports **CO2 infrastructure** development
 - Overcome investment barriers and **accelerate deployment** of low-carbon infrastructure
 - Aims to **streamline permitting** – relevant for CO2 pipeline project approvals
 - New planning and cost-sharing mechanisms to **cross-border networks**.

Planning: CCSA to share first draft with members on 6 June (approx). Feedback period one week.

We may repeat 2 or 3 round on consultations depending on the need. Aim to submit our contribution by 1 Aug.

- CO2 Transport Position Paper: next steps
 - Further dissemination & engagement
 - Address specific points not answered in the paper on separate follow-up documents/briefings:
 - Repurposing
 - Cross-border
- Complement Paper when numbers and figures

Europe-wide CCUS Delivery Plan

Objective: to understand the size of the CCUS project pipeline in Europe, the policy issues and barriers faced by developers, and how the number and size of projects in development compare to country and EU targets.

- CO2 capture projects

- CO2 utilisation projects
- Manufacture of components for CO2 capture
