

CCSA Launches the European CCUS National Associations Forum to strengthen collaboration across Europe

The Carbon Capture and Storage Association (CCSA) today announces the launch of the **European CCUS National Associations Forum**, a new informal European Forum designed to enhance cooperation, knowledge-sharing, and alignment among representatives of European and national CCUS stakeholders.

The Forum is established in response to the rapidly growing momentum behind carbon capture, utilisation, and storage (CCUS), and the increasing need for coordinated action to support the deployment of CCUS technologies in Europe. As countries confirm their climate ambitions and industries invest in decarbonisation, national CCUS associations are playing a critical role in shaping CCUS policy, supporting project development, and helping to shape policy, support market development and address barrier to deployment.

The new Forum will enable these organisations to work more closely together, share best practice, and help inform an effective policy and regulatory framework for CCUS in Europe's net-zero transition. It will also support dialogue in countries where CCUS National Associations have not yet been established, recognising that shared experience and practical lessons can help accelerate progress.

Together, these organisations represent a broad cross-section of the European CCUS value chain and are committed to continued cooperation in of timely CCUS deployment across Europe.
